The House Leaders for Learning are pleased to announce the details of the 2018 Prom which will be held on **Friday 6th July 2018 at The Brabazon Restaurant, Beaulieu Motor Museum**. We have met with Year 11 this morning to introduce the Noadswood Prom Passport and explain that the pupils will be expected to fulfil a merit related criteria to qualify for this privilege.

<i>Plus TWO from the list below</i>
An attendance of 97%-100%
Participation in at least 10 revision/catch up sessions
10 weeks of 100% attendance with full punctuality

As you can see, these are designed to support the work that pupils are hopefully doing anyway in the run up to the GCSEs and should not require them to take on an extra burden of expectation. The criteria have been designed to allow all pupils an excellent chance of success and our vision is for the whole Year Group to be able to attend the Prom in July 2018. In the event of this not being the case, or with a serious breach of discipline, an invitation will be delayed until a dialogue has taken place with the pupil and their parents.

A further letter will be issued in February 2018 to the pupils who have met the criteria, to collect deposits for the Prom with final payment required just after Easter 2018. We have recently issued all Year 11 pupils with details of the local sixth form college open evenings which begin in October, please find further details on the school website.

We hope your child is ready for the challenge of their GCSEs and beginning to become excited about what the future holds for them
