### **Exam Board; Pearson**

In order to be awarded a qualification, a learner must complete and achieve all three components with a grade Level 1 Pass or above and achieve the minimum number of points at a grade threshold.

#### **BTEC FINAL GRADES**

Pass level 2 = (Grade 5 equivalent)

Merit level 2 = (Grade 6 equivalent)

Distinction level 2 = (Grade 8 equivalent)
