BTEC Tech Level 1 and 2 award in Health and Social Care

Exam Board; Pearson

- ▶ In order to be awarded a qualification, a learner must complete and achieve **all three components with a grade Level 1 Pass or above** and achieve the **minimum number of points** at a grade threshold.

BTEC FINAL GRADES

Pass level 2 = (Grade 5 equivalent)

Merit level 2 = (Grade 6 equivalent)

Distinction level 2 = (Grade 8 equivalent)

The Exam component (40%)..

External Exam – 2 hours long. Taken in early February in year 11

- ▶ Attend revision classes



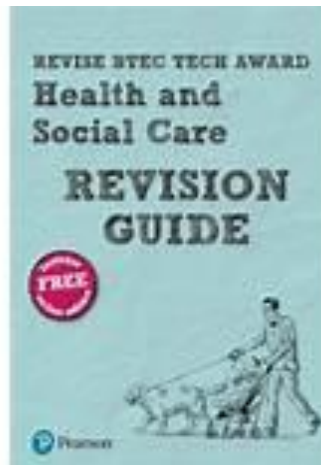
How can parents support?
