# GCSE PE



- ▶ Pupils are assessed on both practical skills and their ability to apply theoretical knowledge.
- ▶ The course consists of:
  - ▶ 2x written exams – 1h 30 minutes each (60%)
  - ▶ 1 piece of coursework (10%)
  - ▶ Practical assessment – 3 sports (30%)
- ▶ All theory work and coursework is completed in school.

# GCSE PE – Practical



- ▶ Due to the current situation, the practical aspect of the course is where we require your assistance.
- ▶ Pupils are assessed in 3 different sports – 1 individual, 1 team sport and the third can be either an individual or a team sport.
- ▶ For example pupil A: Singles Tennis (Individual), Netball (Team) & Gymnastics (Individual)
- ▶ For example pupil B: Singles Badminton (Individual), Football (Team) & Rugby (Team)

# Requirements

- ▶ We require your assistance with gaining video evidence of your child participating in their chosen sports. Currently all GCSE PE moderation is being assessed via video rather than a moderator attending the school to watch the selected pupils live.
- ▶ There are currently no after school clubs or fixtures due to Covid 19, so we need your help with gaining the footage.
- ▶ Footage must show:
  - ▶ Skills (The video can be stopped and edited for these)
  - ▶ Full context match/event (If a match, the video must not be stopped and it must show at least half of a match)
  - ▶ Performer must be easily identifiable
  - ▶ Balanced competition is essential











# Filming



- ▶ If your child does not currently participate outside of school, we will provide opportunities in school for those that don't, however the more video evidence you are able to provide us the better.
- ▶ Once we are able to provide after school sports clubs again, we would strongly encourage all pupils taking GCSE to attend a club, especially if your child does not participate in sport outside of school.
- ▶ When you plan to film your child, they will need to collect the marking criteria from their PE Teacher which explains what needs to be performed. Filming needs to be carried out via a suitable video camera (not a phone or an iPad). We have one in school that we are able to lend out for activities taking place inside.
