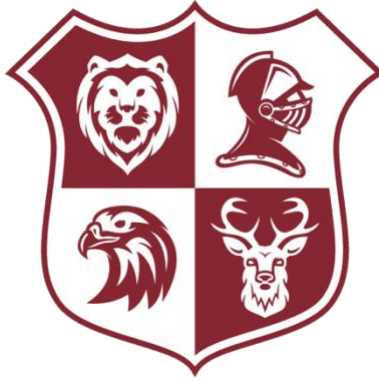

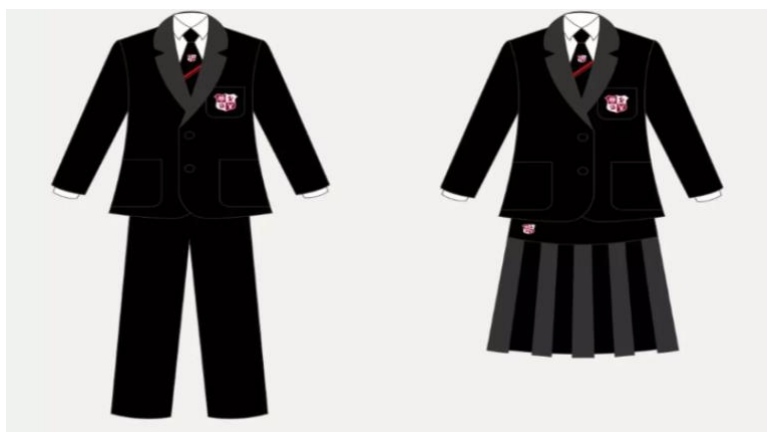

Uniform Policy

Rationale

Here at Noadswood we strive to ensure that students are able to leave school well prepared for further education and the world of work. This includes developing their independence and an understanding of how to dress and act in a professional manner. We have high expectations of our student's appearance, not only because we believe it is right, but because research shows that high expectations results in better academic outcomes



Pupils may choose to wear the school blazer or school jumper or both.	
Blazer	Black with school badge on the pocket
Jumper	Black with school badge. Not to be tucked into trousers or skirt.
Tie	Noadswood School tie with house-coloured stripes. Prefects wear the burgundy tie.
Trousers/Shorts	Plain, black, tailored, loose fitting trousers. No jean or corded fabric or skinny trousers or co Tailored shorts may be worn in the first half of the Autumn term and the Summer term only LEGGINGS MUST NOT BE WORN
Skirt	The Noadswood school skirt must be worn by all pupils from September 2021 . In the meantime, any skirts that need replacing must be with the school skirt. All skirts must be knee length and not rolled up at any time.

Shirt	Plain white with collar, short or long sleeved.
Outer coat/jackets	Coats to be worn on top of the school blazer or jumper. No denim jackets, leather coats or other jumpers/hoodies without zips.
Socks and tights	White or black socks, or plain black tights only. No socks over tights. Tights must be worn from October half term
Shoes	Completely black, formal leather style. NO trainers, boots, canvas shoes or sport style shoes.
Make up	Year 7,8,9 students are not to wear make-up. Year 10 and 11 may wear natural looking subtle make-up. Only discreet mascara/foundation. False eyelashes are not permitted.
Hair	Hair should be traditionally styled. Extreme fashion styles eg shaved heads, beads, tramlines are not permitted. Brightly coloured hair in unnatural shades is not permitted. i.e. only shades of black, brown, auburn, ginger & blonde are allowed.
Nails	Must be short i.e. of a suitable length to cope with practical activities. COLOURED NAIL POLISH MUST NOT BE WORN AND ACRYLICS ARE NOT PERMITTED.
Jewellery	Only one pair of small stud earrings in the lobe of the ear and a watch may be worn. NO OTHER visible body piercings are allowed eg. nose studs, eyebrow rings and tongue studs. Other forms of body piercings (including plastic retainers of any kind), tattoos and ear stretchers are not permitted. No other forms of jewellery will be allowed because of loss or safety. All jewellery must be removed for PE on Health and Safety grounds and the school cannot take responsibility for lost jewellery.

	<p>Girls Outdoor:</p> <p>School rugby shirt or white polo shirt, plain black shorts, Red socks, Trainers/boots</p> <p>Girls Indoors:</p> <p>White polo shirt, plain black shorts or black skort, white socks, trainers</p>
Year 10 and 11	<p>Boys Outdoors:</p> <p>School rugby shirt, Plain black shorts, Red socks, trainers/boots</p> <p>Boys Indoors:</p> <p>School polo shirt, plain black shorts, white socks, trainers</p>
	<p>Girls Outdoor:</p> <p>School rugby shirt or school polo shirt, Black shorts, white socks, trainers/boots</p> <p>Girls Indoors:</p> <p>School polo shirt, plain black shorts or black skort, white socks, trainers</p>
Optional Extras	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Leggings (Must be worn WITH shorts or skort over the top) • House Hoodie (For outside lessons subject to health and safety regulations)
Not Permitted	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Skin-tight shorts (for example, Nike Pro's) • Jewellery (Hampshire Health and safety regulations) • Watch
