Buses*	We have various bus routes that serve the local area. The Hythe circular buses (H1 & H2) stop on North Road, outside the school. Bus routes 8 & 9 stop a short walk away from the school on Upper Mullins lane, or Beaulieu road for any pupils travelling from slightly further afield.

Roads*	The site is access by vehicle on North Road via our entrance gates. We have a one way system on site, meaning vehicles exit via out exit gates on Water Lane.
Walking Routes*	The site can be accessed on foot by a network of footpaths along North Road, Water Lane, as well as adjoining footpaths/cycle paths from neighbouring roads. We have pedestrian access alongside our entrance and exit gates on North Road and Water Lane, as well as an additional gates accessing our school field.
Cycling Routes*	The site can be accessed by bike by a network of local cycle paths including one directly outside our entrance gates joining Cleveland Drive and North Road, Roman Road, which joins Nash Road, a short distance from Noadswood, as well as other dedicated cycle paths in the area such as Claypits lane adjoining Southampton Road.

We have a railing across our field gates which is one of our main pedestrian access points for pupils in the mornings and afternoons.

Our main vehicle entrances gate, has a pedestrian gate alongside accessed by a footpath from Water Lane.

Yes

There is a cycle path from Cleveland Drive adjoining North Road, directly outside our entrance gates.

What is the quality of the pavements like within 500m of the school? (If poor/Inadequate, please record any details)

The footpath along Water Lane is in a poor state, with potholes and jagged edges falling away into a grass verge. The grass verge is also mostly mud. It is not wide enough to accommodate foot traffic heading in opposite directions to both Noadswood and Orchard schools.

Please record any other obstacles or road layout issues within 500 metres of the school entrance which could be deemed as preventing young people or making it more difficult for them to use sustainable transport on the journey to and from school.

There are no zig zag lines outside our exit gates, meaning parents regularly use the junction to pull in to drop children off, or pick them up, and also use this as a turning space.
