Year 10 Personal Learning Reviews – Jan 2025

To provide our students with the opportunity to reflect on their first progress report since starting their GCSEs, we are inviting them to attend a personal learning review (PLR) with their tutor.

Between Tuesday 7th January and Monday 20th January students will be given a 10min appointment with their tutor. These appointments will take place during the morning at either 08:35-08:45 or 08:45-08:55. The tutor will inform each student of their date and time slot.

During this fortnight students do not need to attend their regular tutor time, unless they are meeting their tutor for their PLR, or when they have assembly on Thursday 9th January. However, all students are expected to be in school each day at 08:55 for registration. If for any reason your student needs to be in school at the normal time of 08:45, they can still go to their tutor room and use this as an opportunity to read.

During the PLR tutors will discuss with the students their autumn term progress report, which will provide an opportunity to reflect on their behaviour, effort and independent learning in all subject areas as well as general points around their progress towards their GCSEs this term. Together with their tutor, students will be able to identify areas they need to improve and set themselves two academic targets and one personal target to help them move forward through the rest of Year 10.

This will enable students to reflect with their tutor, to ask questions and seek guidance about any aspects of school life.
