Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 10 Brockenhurst College Taster Day

All students in year 10 are invited to join the College Taster Day at Brockenhurst College on **Tuesday** 24th June 2025 at 9.30am-1.30pm.

During their visit, students will experience taster lessons and explore the college campus. The college will also be providing lunch for the students. Students are asked to take responsibility for their food choices in the light of any usual observances they follow because of allergies or for any other reasons. Students should also bring a water bottle as usual.

Students can wear non-school uniform. Clothing must be suitable for the weather and appropriate to wear. We also ask for students to bring a notepad and pen to make notes.

Due to travel costs, we ask that parents and carers drive students to the college for 9.30am and collect them at the end of the taster day at 1.30pm. When students arrive, they must go straight to Reception where they will be directed to the hall to be registered. Where possible, we encourage students to lift share with friends to reduce traffic and to support other families in getting students to Brockenhurst.

If you are happy for your child to attend this trip, please log in to the Arbor app and provide your consent for your child to attend. If you are using a mobile phone to view the app, please turn the device to landscape and scroll to the bottom right of the page, select Trips and a new screen will show you the trip your child is being offered. Choose the trip and follow the details in order to provide consent. **The deadline for consent to be provided is Tuesday 17**th **June.**

We take our responsibility for the safety and welfare of our pupils seriously at all times. This raises particular issues when pupils are involved in an activity off-site. Before taking students away from the school site, we carry out a thorough risk assessment and take all necessary measures to minimise risks including arranging appropriate levels of supervision by responsibly adults. We expect that students involved in the activity will co-operate fully with the arrangements made and follow closely the instructions of the responsible adults throughout the activity. We therefore reserve the right to refuse a place on the trip to any students where there has been a behaviour concern previously.
