We are able to take a maximum of 144 students to Bude, however, If this trip is oversubscribed, we will determine the places by a fair ballot and those who are unsuccessful will be refunded in full and their name placed on our reserve list.

If you are using a mobile phone to view the app, please turn your device to landscape and scroll to the bottom right of the page, select Trips and a new screen will show you the trip your child is being offered. Choose the trip and follow the details in order to provide consent. Online, via Arbor is our new method of payment and this has been set up for you to pay. The closing date is **4pm on Friday 19**<sup>th</sup> **September**. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium (or has been entitled to Free School Meals in the last 6 years), financial support may be available.
